






## Capacity Building for regional and national stakeholders



The **EuBioNet** is an alliance of **118 EU funded projects and initiatives** dealing with Bioeconomy promotion, communication and support. 


This systemic approach consolidated the EuBioNet central role in stimulating the debate and delivering policy recommendations.
